This responds to your June 8, 2015 request for assistance from the Office of Government Information Services (OGIS), which we received via email. Your request for assistance pertains to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE).

As you are aware, Congress created OGIS to complement existing FOIA practice and procedure; we strive to work in conjunction with the existing request and appeal process. The goal is for OGIS to allow, whenever practical, the requester to exhaust his or her remedies within the agency, including the appeal process. OGIS has no investigatory or enforcement power, nor can we compel an agency to release documents. OGIS serves as the Federal FOIA Ombudsman and our jurisdiction is limited to assisting with the FOIA process.

OGIS staff discussed your request and your concerns with ICE. Upon further consideration, ICE has reopened your appeal and remanded your request for additional processing. ICE will correspond directly with you about this matter.

I hope that OGIS's assistance has been useful to you. At this time, there is no further assistance OGIS can offer. We will close your case.
